3. Description of the training offered:

Byte Back offers two categories of training:

- Computer Foundations 1 & 2 are for adults that are new to computers or need to update their skills.
- Professional Tracks are for students who have mastered essential skills and are ready to earn industry-recognized certifications, get personalized career coaching, and launch a career using technology.

4. Trainees have the opportunity to earn the following industry-recognized certifications:

- CompTIA A+
- Microsoft Office Specialist (MOS) Word
- Microsoft Office Specialist (MOS) Excel

5. Am I eligible? Those who are eligible must be over the age of 18 and have a High School diploma or GED. For certification classes, there are salary requirements that will be shared once the individual is contacted to begin the Admissions process.

- Must be 18 or older

- Have a High School diploma or GED®

Note- Professional Track certification classes are open to those meeting income limits and passing entrance assessments.

6. What is the application process?

The courses start at different levels with a variety of goals in mind, allowing the participant to jump in at their level and work toward the future they want – with the support they need. All Byte Back classes are free for Scholars, thanks to generous funding from our partners, including local governments, foundations, corporations, and individuals.
