MARYLAND PROOF OF OFFICIAL SCHOOL WITHDRAWAL

Students aged 16 and 17 are subject to the Maryland Compulsory Attendance Law, <u>Education Article §7-301</u> of the Maryland Code, and must be officially withdrawn from high school before registering for the GED® Test.

Step 1: A GED® test taker **account must be created** at <u>GED.COM</u> **before** submitting this form to the Maryland Department of Labor to get the age restriction lifted for 16 and 17 year-olds.

Step 2: THIS FORM MUST BE COMPLETED BY THE SCHOOL OFFICIAL ONLY
