### 1. Organization providing the training:

### 3. Description of the training offered:

Goodwill Industries of the Chesapeake and the Community College of Baltimore County have partnered to offer a Building Maintenance Technician training opportunity. This in-person, evening, classroom-based training will last approximately six months, allowing participants to complete accredited college courses, earn an industry credential and obtain employment with one of our employer partners.

### 4. Trainees have the opportunity to earn the following industry-recognized credentials:

- EPA 608 Certification
- Apartment Maintenance Certification

### 5. Am I eligible?

Interested applicants should be 18 years of age or older, have a high school diploma, have no felony convictions on their record, be able to pass a drug test, and be willing to learn and work in Baltimore County.

#### 6. What is the application process?

Interested applicants should contact Goodwill's Intake team at <u>intake@gooddwillches.org</u> or call 443-827-2736 to begin the enrollment process with Goodwill. Once enrolled, applicants will then be screened by the program's Career Navigator to assess eligibility and fitness for the program. The pre-screen process will include a TABE Assessment, background check, drug screen, and panel interview.

7. How much can I expect to earn if I complete this program and obtain employment in the Building Maintenance field?

Expected average hourly wage: \$18.00 per hour.
