

If you're interested in a career in <u>Construction/Heavy Equipment Operator</u>, this training could be a good option.

1. Organization providing the training:

Hagerstown Community College (HCC)

2. Physical location where training occurs:

Hagerstown Community College main campus, 11400 Robinwood Drive Hagerstown, MD

3. Description of the training offered:

Construction Skilled Trades Employment Pathways (CSTEP) offers a 100-hour program for heavy equipment operation. New construction projects are hampered by site preparation, which is provided by heavy equipment operators using a variety of earth moving equipment. You will receive hands-on training safely using equipment at a work site, performing inspection and equipment startup, identifying preventive maintenance issues, practicing digging and trenching operations, moving and grading materials, and loading vehicles and securing materials.

4. Trainees have the opportunity to earn the following industry-recognized credentials:

Participants will earn an OSHA 10 for Construction certification and National Center for Construction Education and Research micro-credentials.

5. Am I eligible?

Applicants must be Maryland residents who are unemployed or underemployed.

6. What is the application process?

Applicants may apply online at www.hagerstowncc.edu/Construction.

7. How much can I expect to earn if I complete this program and obtain employment in the construction trades field?

Average starting wage has some variables depending on trade but generally range from \$20 to \$24 per hour for entry-level operators.

8: How much do I have to pay for this program?

The Construction Equipment Operator program costs \$2,500 with up to \$2,000 scholarships for qualified applications. Additional scholarship options are also available from HCC's Foundation.
