3. Description of the training offered:

The HTP Homes Building Second Chances Program (BSCP) offers construction skills and workforce readiness training. You will receive up to 12 months of hands-on skills training while rehabilitating a vacant house in Baltimore City. You will learn all aspects of construction including, tools and site safety, measuring, demolition, reading blueprints, framing and carpentry, painting, and plumbing. In addition, you will be partnered with a behavioral health counselor to address any barriers that might impede your success. If necessary, you will also receive assistance to help you obtain a driver's license to expand your employment opportunities. When you are prepared, we work with our local employer partners to find you a good-paying career-focused job.

4. Trainees have the opportunity to earn the following industry-recognized credentials:

Participants will earn an OSHA-10 for Construction certification.

5. Am I eligible?

Applicants must be Maryland residents who are at least 18 years old and live in Baltimore City or Anne Arundel County.

6. What is the application process?

Entry-level earnings will range from \$20 per hour to \$23 per hour depending on the trade.
