3. Description of the training offered:

This training is meant to prepare individuals for entry level IT positions. Per Scholas is a national nonprofit that drives positive and proven social change in communities across the country providing rigorous and tuition-free technology training and professional development. The length of each training is dependent upon the industry recognized certification course the learner chooses to pursue, but typically ranges from 12 to 15 weeks.

4. Trainees have the opportunity to earn the following industry-recognized certifications:

- CompTIA A+
- Google IT

5. Am I eligible?

Admission to Per Scholas is needs based. You may be eligible if you:

- Are a Maryland resident
- Are 18 and older
- Have a High School Diploma or GED®
- Have interest in pursuing a career in IT
- Are a U.S. citizen or authorized to work in the U.S.

The program focuses on training those who are unemployed and underemployed. Women, youth, and veterans strongly encouraged to apply. If you are a veteran, you must have been honorably discharged within the last 10 years.
