Description of the training offered:

Participants will receive structured training tailored to specific high-demand occupations within the transportation and construction sectors. Training will combine classroom instruction, hands-on skills development, and paid work-based learning, aligned with industry standards and employer needs; participants will earn at least one industry-recognized credential upon completion. In addition, wraparound supports such as case management, transportation assistance, childcare support, and job placement services will be provided to improve completion and employment outcomes.

Participants will begin soft skills training in the second half of junior year, receive related instruction and industry-recognized credentials during the summer following junior year, and apprenticeship employment during their senior year.

Trainees have the opportunity to earn the following industry-recognized certifications:

NCCER certifications, CPR/First Aid, OSHA safety certifications, trade-specific certificates, and other state-approved credentials

Am I eligible?

This program is for Baltimore City Public Schools juniors interested in the construction trade who meet the following eligibility requirements:

- Students must have 2.0 or higher in CTE-related courses (or overall GPA if at a non-CTE school)
- 70% or higher attendance for school



What is the application process?

Those who meet the eligibility requirements must go through an application and interview process as well as career readiness training and related instruction prior to beginning on-the-job training. Baltimore's Promise with partner with Baltimore City Public Schools and Urban Alliance for the application process, and someone from one of the three organizations will reach out within one week of inquiry.
