CCBC will provide local job seekers with training, supportive services, and industry-recognized credentials in Construction. After completing the training, participants will be placed in the registered apprenticeship. Participants will earn and learn while enrolled in the apprenticeship. Training programs include laborer; carpentry; ironwork; masonry, and cement finishing; plumbing, pipefitting, and steamfitting; heating and air conditioning, and refrigeration and installation; electrical.

Trainees have the opportunity to earn the following industry-recognized certifications:

- National Center for Construction Education and Research (NCCER) Core: Introduction to Basic
- Construction Skills (or similar certification based on industry feedback)
- OSHA 10-Hour Construction or General Industry
- CPR and First Aid
