Description of the training offered:

Living Classrooms Pre-Apprenticeship Plumbing Training is a 9-week program that provides participants with foundational knowledge and hands-on skills needed to pursue entry-level employment in the plumbing and construction industries. The training introduces participants to residential and commercial plumbing systems, industry safety standards, tool identification and usage, pipe installation and repair techniques, blueprint reading, and basic plumbing maintenance procedures.

Participants receive instruction in workplace safety, including OSHA principles, proper use of plumbing equipment, measurement and layout techniques, water supply and drainage systems, pipe fitting, fixture installation, and troubleshooting common plumbing issues. The program also emphasizes employability skills such as communication, teamwork, problem-solving, professionalism, and job readiness.

Hands-on learning opportunities allow participants to apply technical skills in simulated or real-world environments under instructor guidance. Case management and employment support services may also be provided to help participants overcome barriers to employment and transition into the workforce.

Trainees have the opportunity to earn the following industry-recognized certifications:

- OSHA 10
- First/Aid CPR



Am I eligible?

- Must be at least 18 years of age (or age requirement established by the program).
- State Identification
- Must demonstrate an interest in pursuing employment in plumbing, construction, maintenance, or related skilled trades industries.
- Must be physically able to perform training activities that may include standing for extended periods, lifting materials, bending, and working with tools and equipment.
- Baltimore City Resident

What is the application process?

Interested applicants must complete the following steps to be considered for enrollment in the Plumbing Training Program:

- Attend information sessions
- Provide required documents
- Participate in Intake and Assessment Process: Complete TABE testing, employment readiness assessment, and formal intake.
- Attend one week of essential skills training

How much can I expect to earn if I complete this program and obtain employment?

Average hourly wage after the completion of training is between \$18-20 per hour.
