Registration information will be taken prior to the beginning of the course to determine tuition eligibility.

- **Fundamentals of welding**
- **Intermediate stick welding**
- **Intermediate gas metal arc welding**

The course will provide the student with the skills to pass a minimum of 2 national level welding certifications in 9 weeks.

This class is designed to provide necessary knowledge and skills for an entry-level welder. Oxy-Fuel, Gas Tungsten Arc (TIG), Gas Metal Arc (MIG) and Shielded Metal Arc (Stick) processes are taught with 40% theory and 60% hands on practice. Additional instruction on basic metallurgy, welding codes, nondestructive examination, and welding symbols will be presented. Upon successful completion of the course, students will receive an Earlbeck Certificate of Completion.

The Earlbeck Mobile Welder Training and Testing Facility is a custom designed 40-foot trailer containing eight welding booths. It is fully self-contained with inverter welding machines, 70KW generator, cylinder gases, ventilation, and heat.
