Agenda

Quorum Announced and Meeting Called to Order

A quorum was announced by Chair, Ms. Danielle Anderson, and the meeting was called to order at 10:00 a.m.

Approval of Agenda

Chair, Ms. Danielle Anderson asked for a motion to approve the agenda with amendments to eliminate 6. Old Business A. Inspection Report. Ms. Tammy Ehrbaker made a motion to approve the agenda with amendments, seconded by Ms. Trai Dagucon-Hunt and the agenda was unanimously approved.

Approval of December 6, 2021 Minutes

The minutes of the December 6, 2021 meeting were reviewed by the Board. Chair, Ms. Danielle Anderson asked for a motion to approve the minutes. A motion was made by Ms. Tammy Ehrbaker to approve the minutes, seconded by Ms. Trai Dagucon-Hunt and the motion unanimously passed.

New Business

A. STAFFING UPDATE

Deputy Director Nicole Fletcher stated that the Department of Barbers and Cosmetology were no longer located at 500 N Calvert St. The Department's new location is 1100 N Eutaw St, Room 121, Baltimore, MD 21201. The Department also welcomes our new Executive Director Mr. John Bull. Mr. Bull has worked for the Department of Health for 11 years and retired from Anne Arundel County Police Department after 20 years. Ms. Fletcher also announced that we have two new board members, Ms. Rosalind Hosley who is a Cosmetologist member and Ms. Kelly Canty who is a Consumer member. The Licensing Supervisor position has also been filled by Ms. Leslie "Zo" Braxton. Ms. Braxton started as a per diem inspector for the board of barbers and cosmetology and become a full time inspector for 5 plus years. The board welcome all new team members.

B. APPRENTICE HAIRSTYLIST RESTART- MARGARET-ANN TAYLOR FRANTZ

Ms. Margaret-Ann Taylor Frantz received her first apprentice license in 2019. She did not complete the program due to her old sponsor no longer working there. The Board asked a series of questions to Ms. Frantz concerning the case out of concern that she and sponsor understood the process of entering hours and the importance of the training/orientation. After reviewing the documentation presented to the Board, Ms. Tammy Ehrbaker motioned to approve the restart of Ms. Frantz apprenticeship, seconded by Ms. Trai Dagucon-Hunt and the motion unanimously passed.

C. APPRENTICE NAIL TECHNICIAN RESTART- PRAMILA BHADARI

Ms. Pramila Bhadari received her first apprentice nail technician license in 2020. She did not complete the program due to the COVID pandemic. After reviewing the documentation presented to the Board, Ms. Trai Dagucon-Hunt motioned to approve the restart of Ms. Bhadari's nail technician apprenticeship, seconded by Ms. Tammy Ehbaker and the motion unanimously passed.

D. LEGISLATIVE SESSION HB 448

Deputy Director Nicole Fletcher stated that Legislation session House Bill 448 was introduced on January 20, 2022. The purpose of the bill will be for the Supervision of Apprentice for the purpose of increasing the maximum number of apprentice that certain licensed cosmetologist may directly train and supervise. The ration would go from 1 sponsor to 1 apprentice, to 1 sponsor and 2 apprentice.
